



Polycom OBi302 expands your service portfolio by enhancing the communication possibilities of home offices with flexibility in voice, fax and modem applications as they transition to the digital communications world. With Polycom, it's possible to keep analog phones and fax machines and use them with new VoIP services. Simply connect up to 2 analog phones or fax machines, power and internet to the adapter to start transitioning to VoIP services.

- Active Internet Phone Service Subscription with All Required SIP Credentials to Make & Receive Calls (Optional)

Alarm Monitoring


Your OBi can help you monitor your security system status and notify you of alarms by sending email and text messages from OBiTALK.

Choose one of the following 3 options:

- Do Not monitor my alarm
- Let OBi monitor my alarm communication to the Alarm Service Company and notify me of the status



Alarm Service Company and notify me of the status
Let OBi be my own Alarm



FAX TO EMAIL



OBiFAX

Getting a fax sent to your email address is easy with OBiFAX. Just select a service to use as your OBiFAX service and tell people to send faxes to the number associated with that service. When a fax is sent, you will receive an email from OBiFAX with the actual fax as a PDF attachment.

IMPORTANT: When you select the service for OBiFAX you will no longer be able to accept a call on the phone attached to your OBi. All incoming calls are considered fax transmissions.

Because of this, we recommend that you create a dedicated phone number (i.e. Google Voice) for sending and receiving faxes on OBiFAX (separate number from your regular voice call number), and configure that fax number on one of the available SP slots on your obitalk.com configuration.
